## Where did Love Field Get it's Name?

On September 4, 1913, First Lieutenant Moss Lee Love, 11th

Cavalry was killed in a Type C Wright pusher bi-plane at North Island, San Diego, California, practicing for his Military Aviator Test. He had been under the instruction of Lt. Frank P. Lahm in the Philippines in the Spring of 1912. Lt. Love was born on September 16, 1879 in Fairfax, Va. He was appointed to the Army from civil life and received his commission as 2nd Lieutenant on December I, 1910.

He was promoted to First Lieutenant, 7th Cavalry on December I, 1910 and ordered to the Phil-

ippines in early 1911. There he received verbal authority to take



flying instructions from Lt. Lahm. Lt. Love then returned to the United States and was assigned to the 11th Cavalry. In April 1913, he was detailed for aviation duty with the Signal Corps and

ordered to Texas City, Texas with the 1st Aero Squadron. He was relieved of this post in June and ordered to San Diego for duty with the Signal Corps Aviation School. On September 4, 1913, Lt. Love was killed in an airplane crash in San Diego.

He was the eighth aviation officer to be killed and the 10th fatality in Army aviation. Love Field was named by the United States Army on October

19, 1917, in honor of Lieutenant Moss Lee Love.







#### **Scheduled Runway and Taxiway Closures**

All closures will be coordinated through Airport Operations and will be permitted based on weather and operational impact.

- Sun/Jan 15<sup>th</sup> 2300 Mon/May 15<sup>th</sup> 1700: Taxiway B closed between Taxiway B1 and Taxiway R for Taxiway B Rehabilitation Project.
- Repainting, realigning Vehicle Service Road and RON B starting Jan 15<sup>th</sup>
- Mon/Jan 16<sup>th</sup> 0500 Fri/Apr 14<sup>th</sup> 1700: Runway 18-36 closed between Runway 13R-31L and Taxiway L Runway 18-36 Conversion Taxiway Echo Rehabilitation Project.
- Mon/Jan 16<sup>th</sup> 0500 Fri/Apr 14<sup>th</sup> 1700: Taxiway C closed between Taxiway D and Taxiway C4 for Runway 18-36 Conversion Taxiway Echo Rehabilitation Project.
- Mon/Jan 16<sup>th</sup> 0700 Tue/Jan 24<sup>th</sup> 1700: Taxiway A closed between Runway 13L-31R and Runway 18-36 for RIM project.
- Wed/Jan 18<sup>th</sup> 2300 Thu/Jan 19<sup>th</sup> 0600: Runway 13L-31R closed for Airfield Maintenance.
- Wed/Jan 18<sup>th</sup> 0700 Sun/Mar 19<sup>th</sup> 1700: Taxiway A closed between Runway 18-36 and Taxiway D for pavement repairs.
- Wed/Jan 18<sup>th</sup> 0700 Sun/Mar 19<sup>th</sup> 1700: Taxiway N closed south of the entrance to Business Jet Center for pavement repairs.

#### **ONGOING AIRFIELD CLOSURES:**

- Taxiway J closed indefinitely.
- Taxiway W closed until Tue/Feb 14<sup>th</sup> for safety area rut removal and shoulder repairs.
