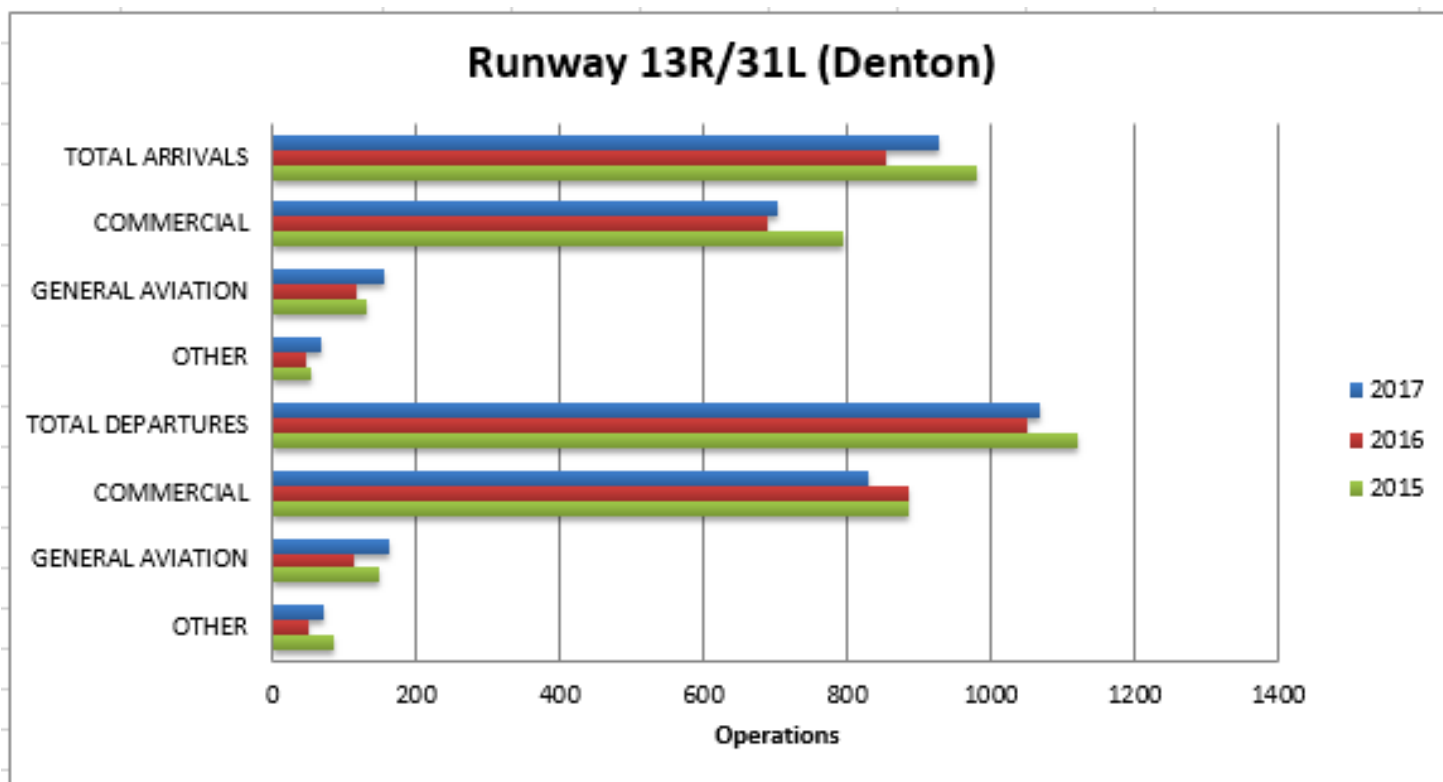
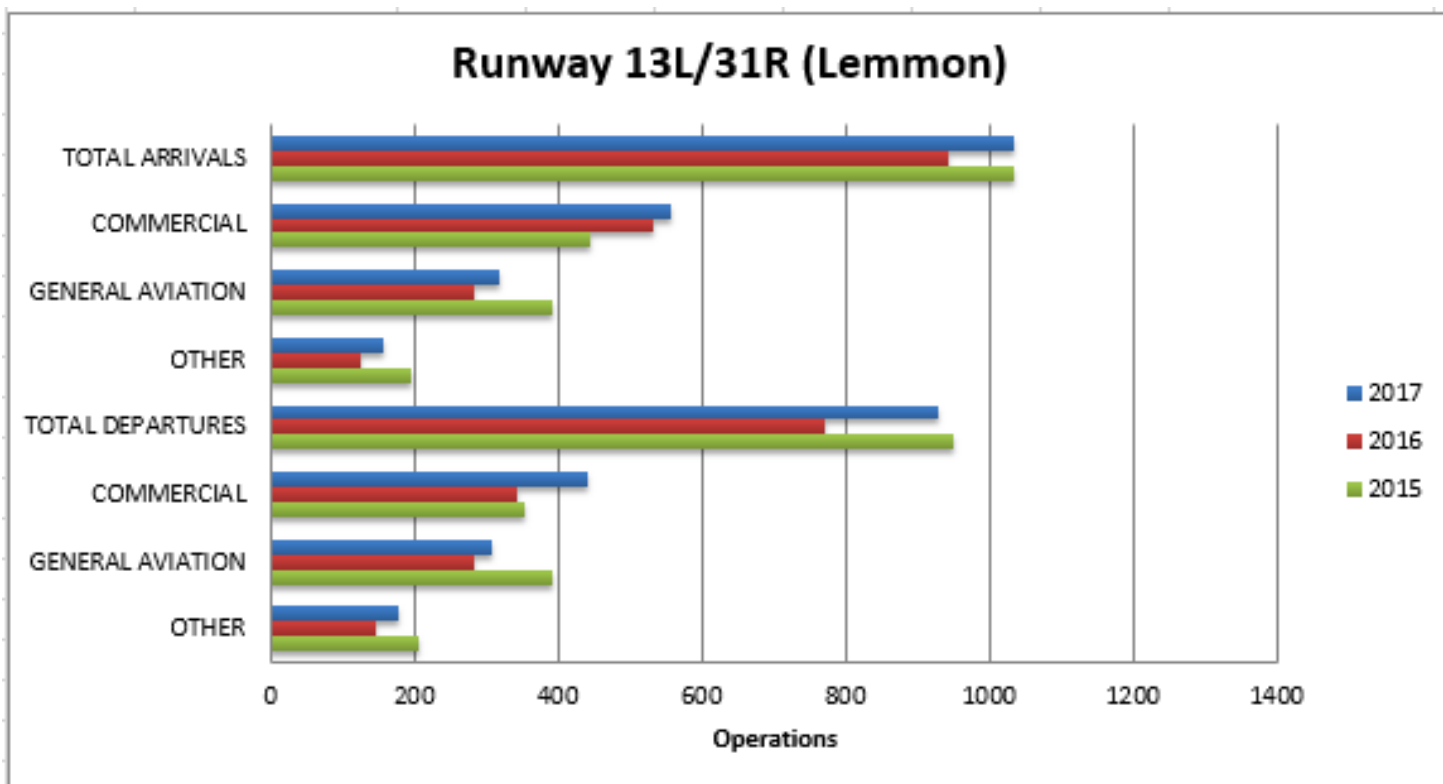

FUTURE / PLANNED CLOSURES

- Wed/Jul 5th 0500 – Thu/Oct 5th 0600: Runway 18-36 Conversion – Taxiway Echo Rehabilitation Project closures:
 - Runway 18-36 closed between Taxiway D1 and Taxiway D3
 - Taxiway C5
 - Taxiway D2
- Sat/Jul 8th 2300 – Sun/Jul 9th 0600: Runway 13L-31R closed for work with the Taxiway B Phase II project.
- Sun /Jul 9th 2300 – Mon/Jul 10th 0600: Runway 13L-31R closed for work with the Taxiway B Phase II project.

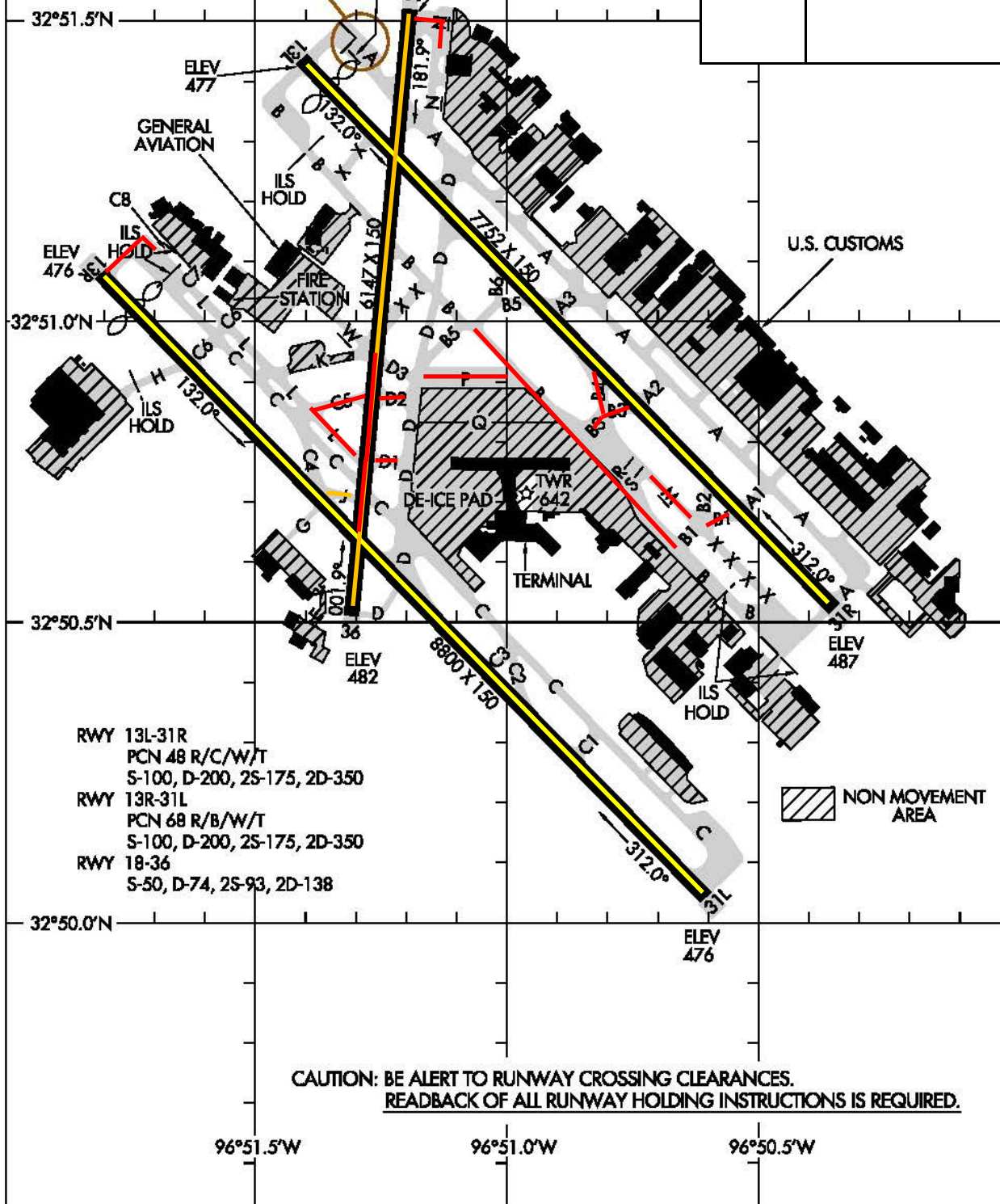
