




Target Areas





Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements Project - Overview



The City of Dallas Department of Aviation is designing improvements to Lemmon Avenue along the Dallas Love Field boundary.

- Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements Project is fulfilling certain priorities identified as part of the Good Neighbor Program
- A key purpose is to help create a better quality of life and safety improvements along Lemmon Avenue
- Project limits include Lemmon Avenue from Mockingbird Lane to Shorecrest Drive, and Shorecrest Drive from Lemmon Avenue to Webb Chapel Extension



Project Overview

Major design features of the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancement Project may include:

- Enhanced landscaping, urban design elements, and gateway features
- Pedestrian and bicycle paths
- Decorative streetlights
- Intersection improvements with new traffic signals and crosswalks
- Two neighborhood parks
- Enhanced bus shelters





Lemmon/Bluffview Intersection



The Department of Aviation is partnering with DART, Department of Public Works and Department of Transportation to undertake improvements to the intersection of Lemmon Avenue and Bluffview Boulevard.

- Contract put out for bid February 2020
- Construction to begin June 2020
- Completion scheduled for August 2020
- A new traffic signal with pedestrian phasing and pathways
- High visibility crosswalks and intersection safety lighting
- Expect lane closures during construction

NATIONAL PARK SERVICE

- The National Parks Service (NPS) has had several meetings with:
 - The Department of Aviation
 - Other supporting departments within the City
- The NPS is contacting local interest and community outreach groups
 - Their goal is to identify interest groups
- NPS to finish the outreach phase of this project within the next month



Runway 13R-31L Reconstruction




Runway Construction 13R-31L

- Closed for approximately nine months beginning January 2021
- Mailer to local residents prior
- Aircraft operations will move to 13L-31R (Lemmon Avenue runway)
- Aircraft noise is anticipated to be temporarily shifted
- Check DAL website and social media accounts for construction updates



Airport Alternate Entry

- 11 original alternatives reviewed
- A shortlist of alternatives to be analyzed in the spring of 2020
- Will include alternate transportation modes
- Will be presented to Dallas City Council in late spring/summer of 2020
- Separate community engagement opportunities coming soon






Airport Alternate Entry Analysis

- 2. Diverging Diamond Interchange
- 3. Direct Ram Interchange
- 4. U-Turn at Airdrome Drive for traffic coming from west
- 5. Mockingbird Lane/Waddell Avenue
- 6. Shorecrest Drive
- 7. Bridge from Northwest Highway
- 8. Shorecrest Drive west of Runway 13R-31L
- 9. Lemmon Ave/Shorecrest Drive Intersection
- 10. Lemmon Ave/George Coker Circle Intersection
- 11. Denton Drive
- 12. Do Nothing




