



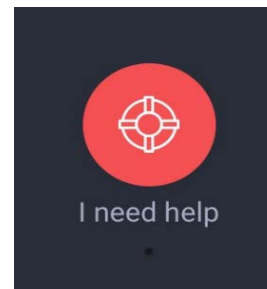

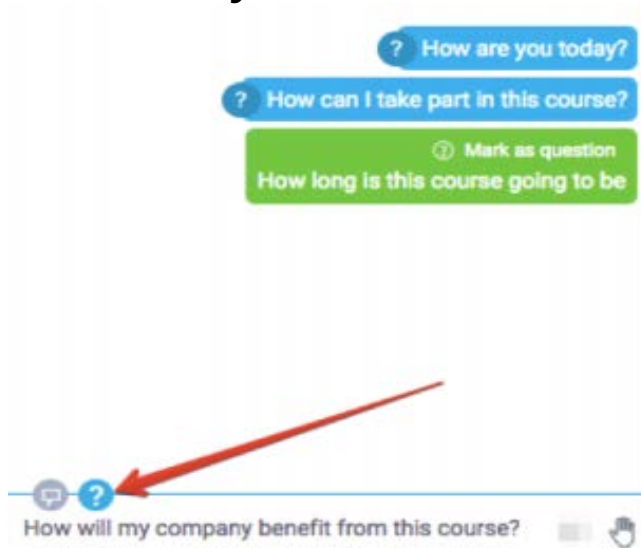

# How to Ask a Question

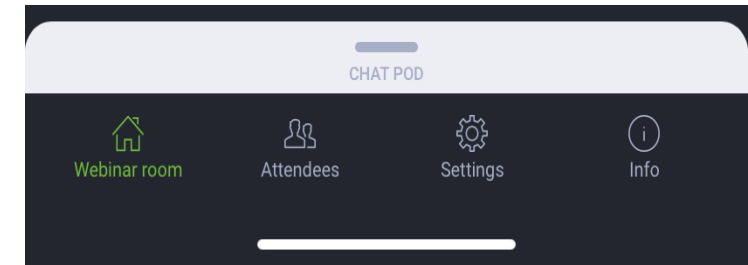
## Computer:

If on a computer, click on the **blue question mark** in the chat box to send your message as a question. All chats submitted with a question mark at the end will also be automatically submitted.

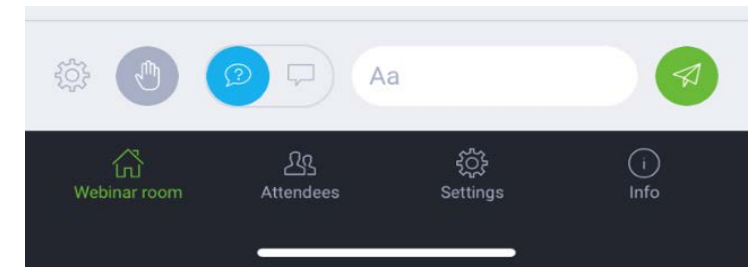


## Mobile App:

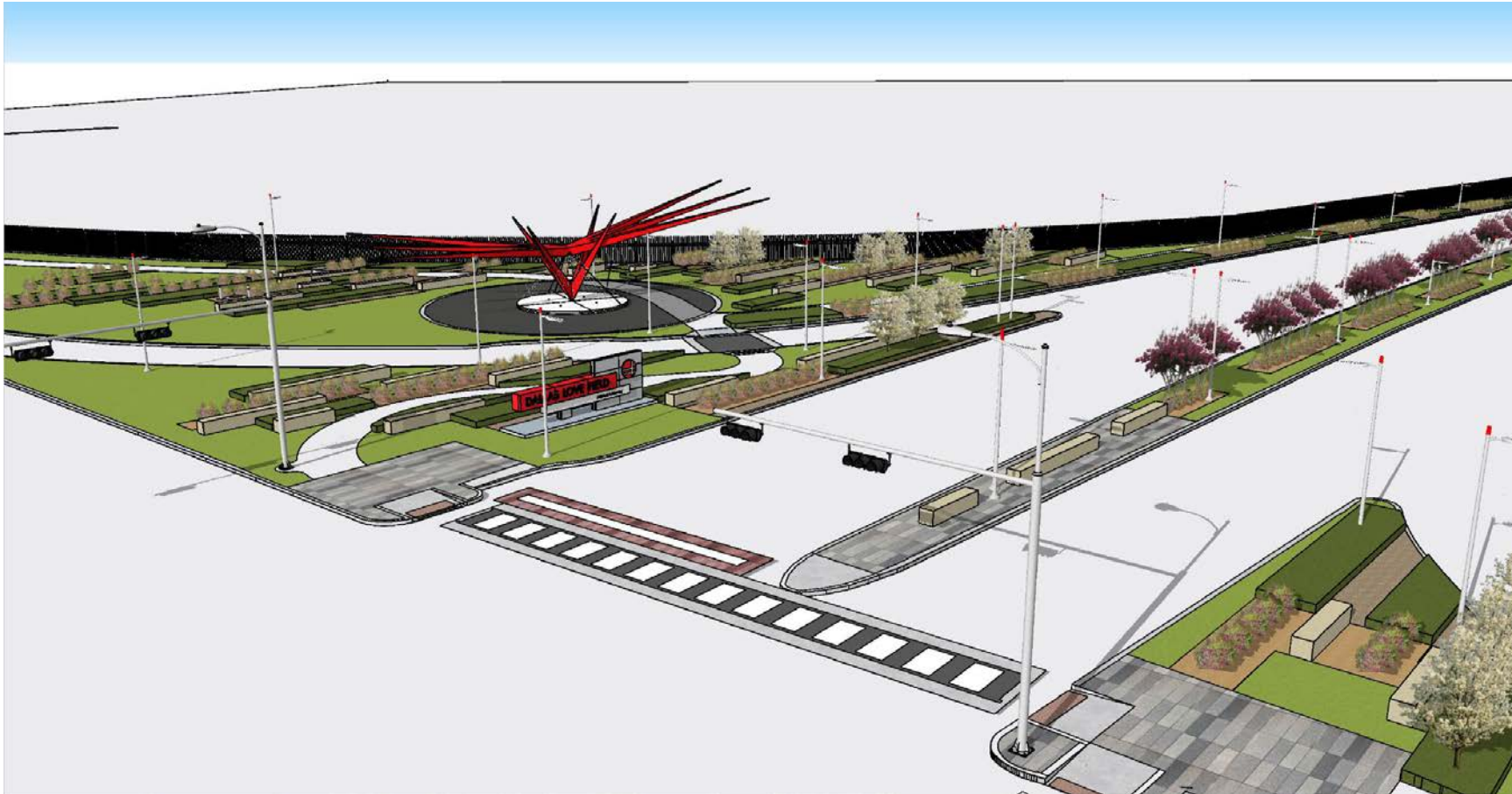
# Lemmon Avenue/Bluffview Intersection



The Department of Aviation is partnering with DART, Department of Public Works and the Department of Transportation to undertake improvements to the intersection of Lemmon Avenue and Bluffview Boulevard.

- Construction starting this month
- Completion scheduled for later this year (2020)
- A new traffic signal with pedestrian phasing and pathways
- High visibility crosswalks and intersection safety lighting
- Expect lane closures and turn restrictions during construction

- Public Art

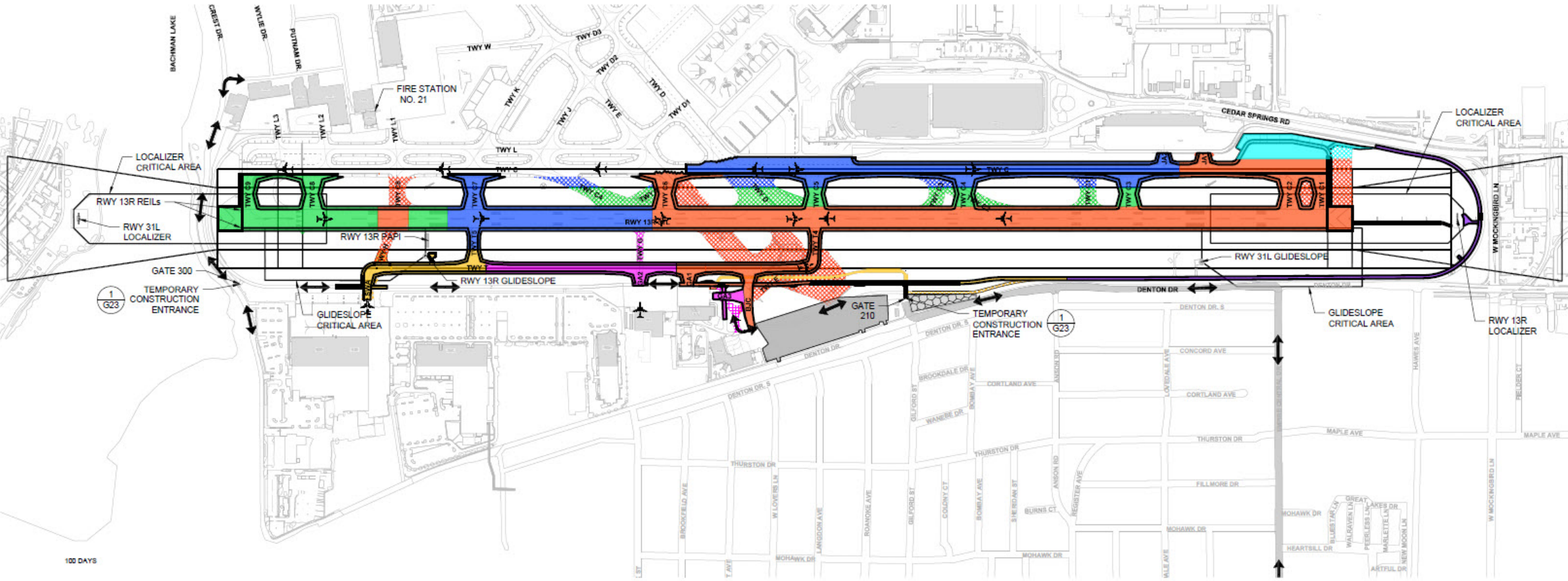
# Runway 13R-31L Reconstruction



## Runway Construction 13R-31L

- Closed for approximately nine months beginning January 2021
- Mailer to local residents scheduled for November 2020
- Aircraft operations will move to 13L-31R (Lemmon Avenue runway)
- Aircraft noise is anticipated to be temporarily shifted
- Check DAL website and social media accounts for construction updates

# *Alternate Entry Analysis*



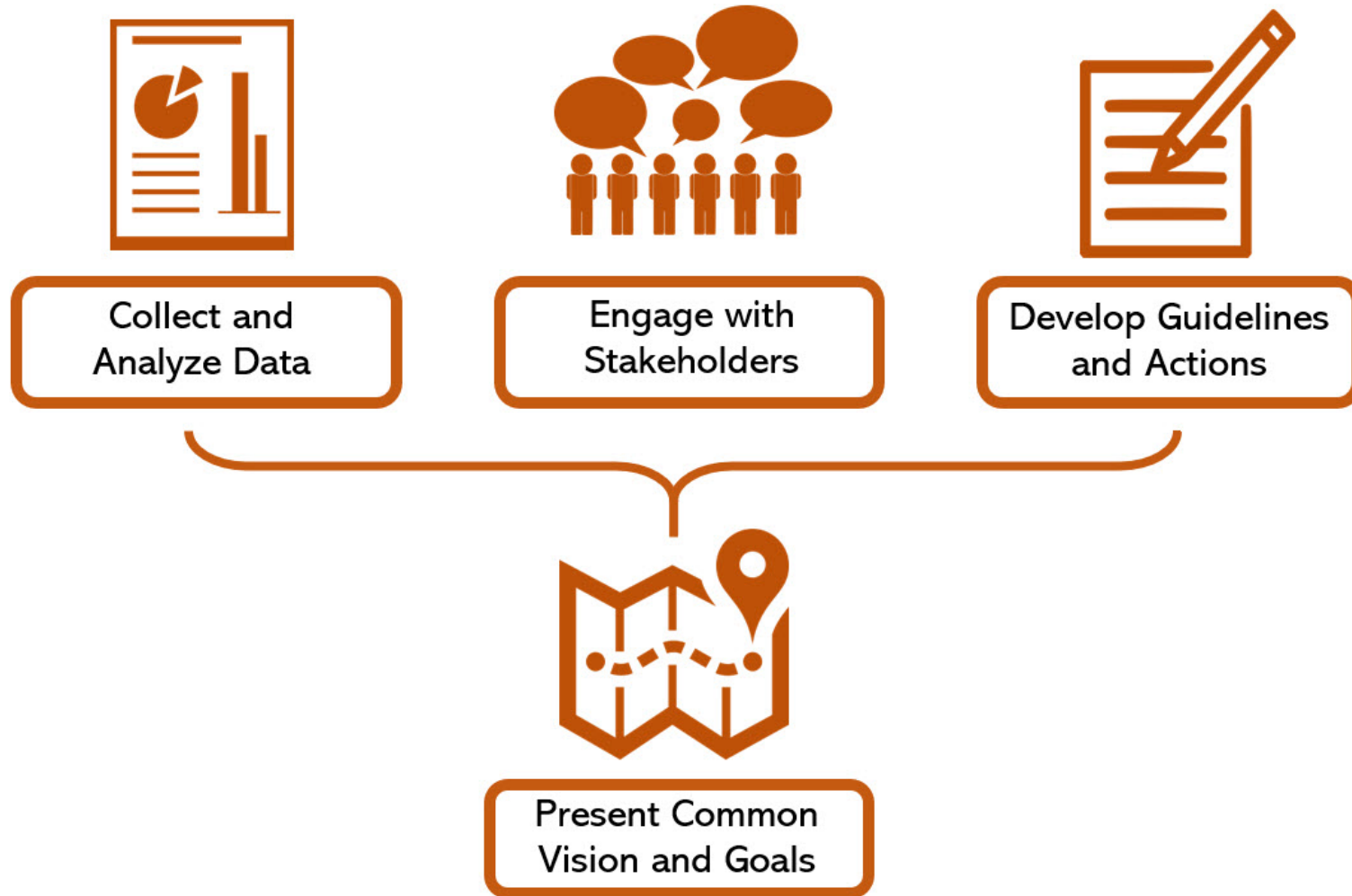
- 11 original alternatives reviewed, five (5) shortlisted

  - Safety, mobility, congestion, security and operational risks

# *Love Field Loop Trail*



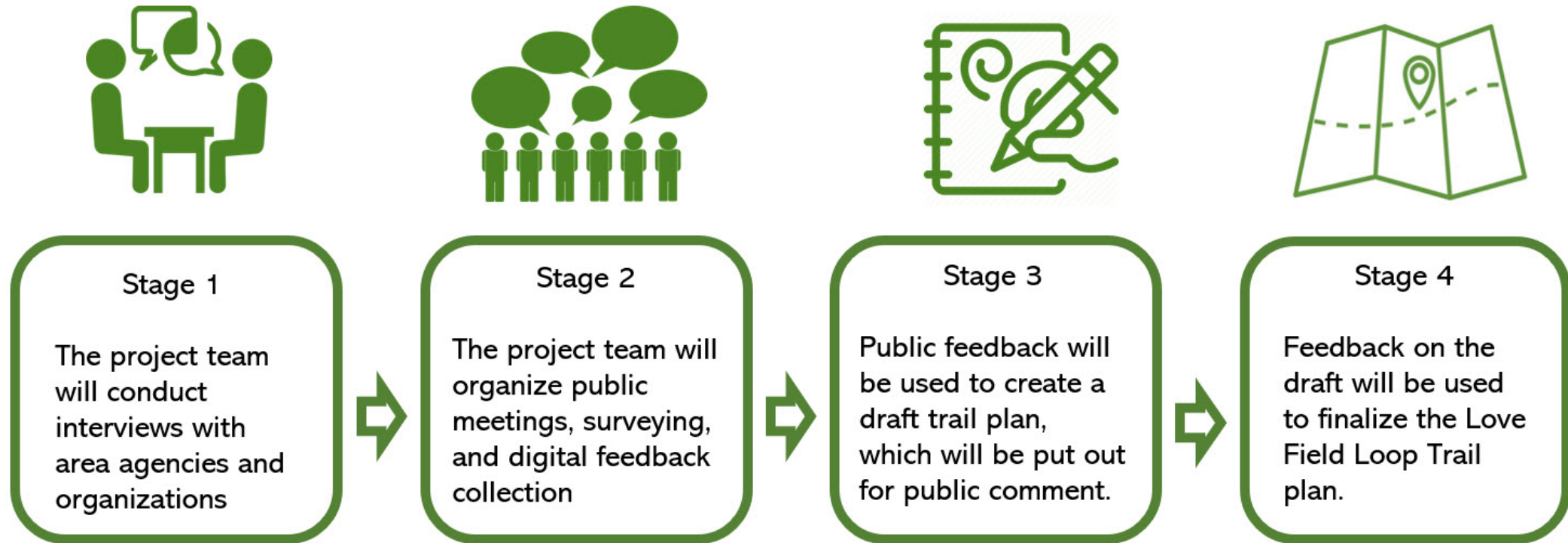
- The National Parks Service (NPS) Rivers, Trails, and Conservation Assistance (RTCA) program supports:
  - Community-led conservation and outdoor recreation across the nation
  - Facilitation, public engagement, planning and design
- Partnership history:
  - The City of Dallas applied for NPS assistance in 2019
  - Various City departments included on the planning team
  - Multiple stakeholders and community groups are providing feedback

# Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements

Major design features of the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancement Project may include:

- Enhanced landscaping, urban design elements and gateway features
- Pedestrian and bicycle paths
- Decorative streetlights
- Intersection improvements with new traffic signals and crosswalks
- Two neighborhood parks
- Enhanced bus shelters

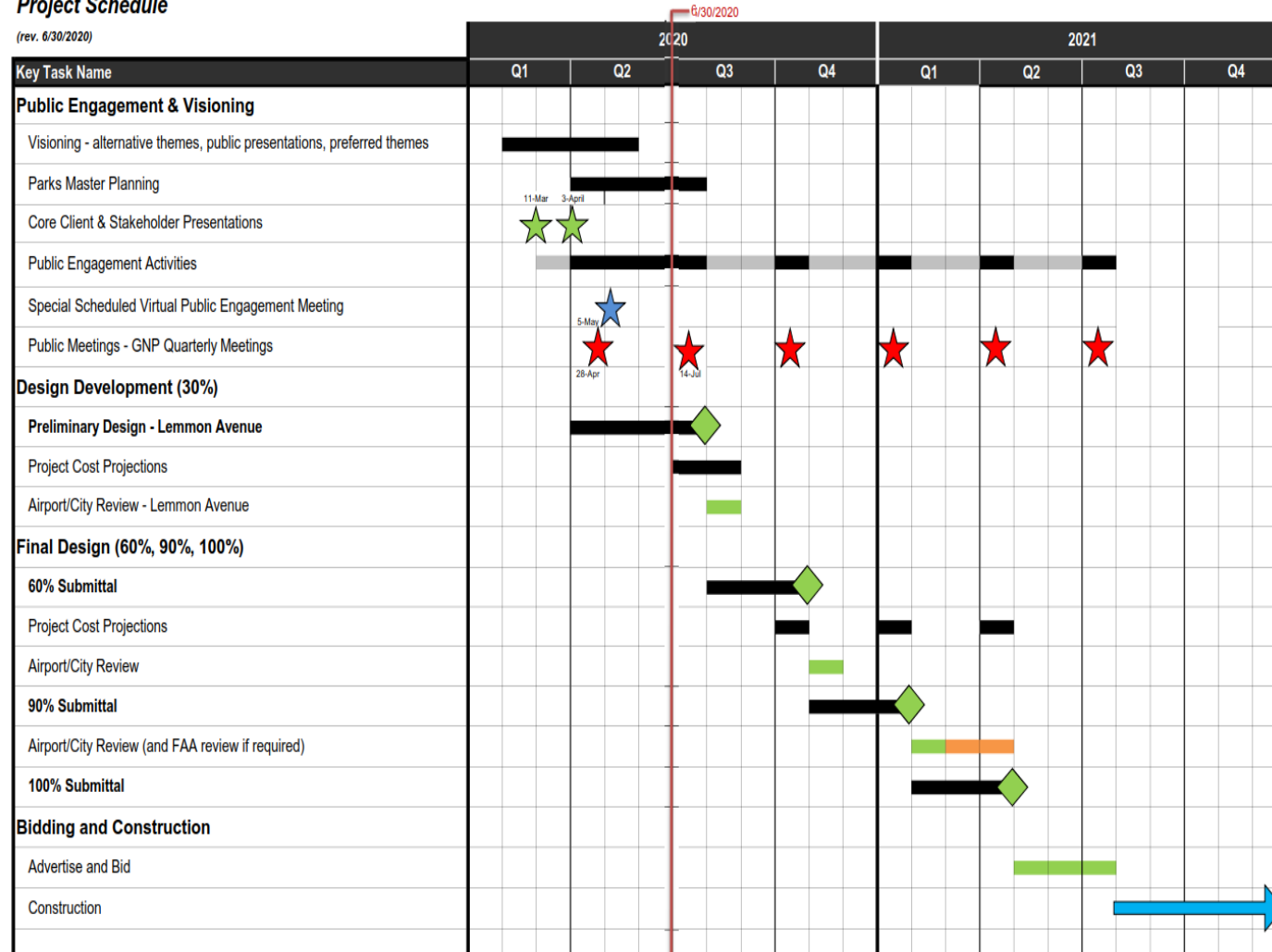

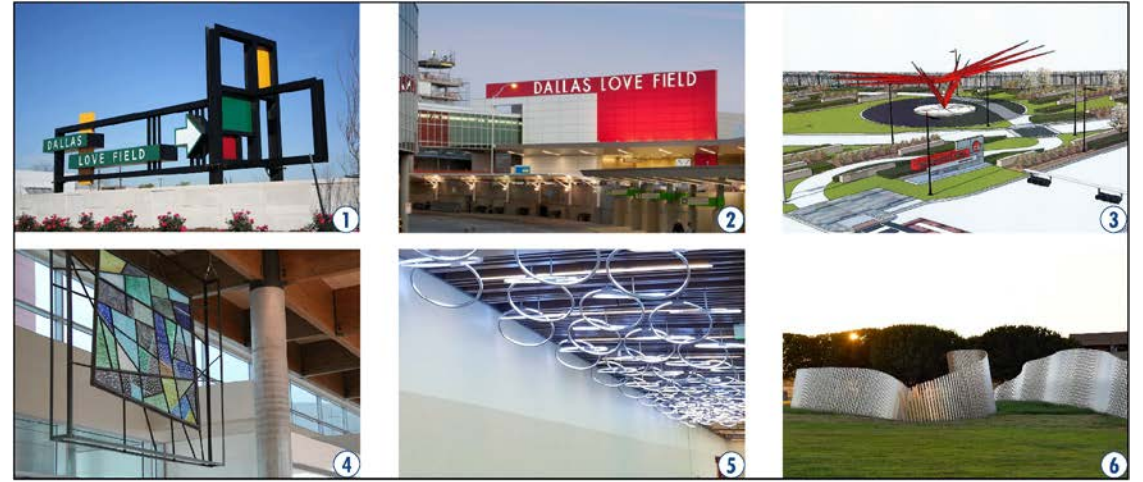
### Schedule Highlights:

- Ongoing public updates utilizing GNP Meetings, GNP Newsletter and project website

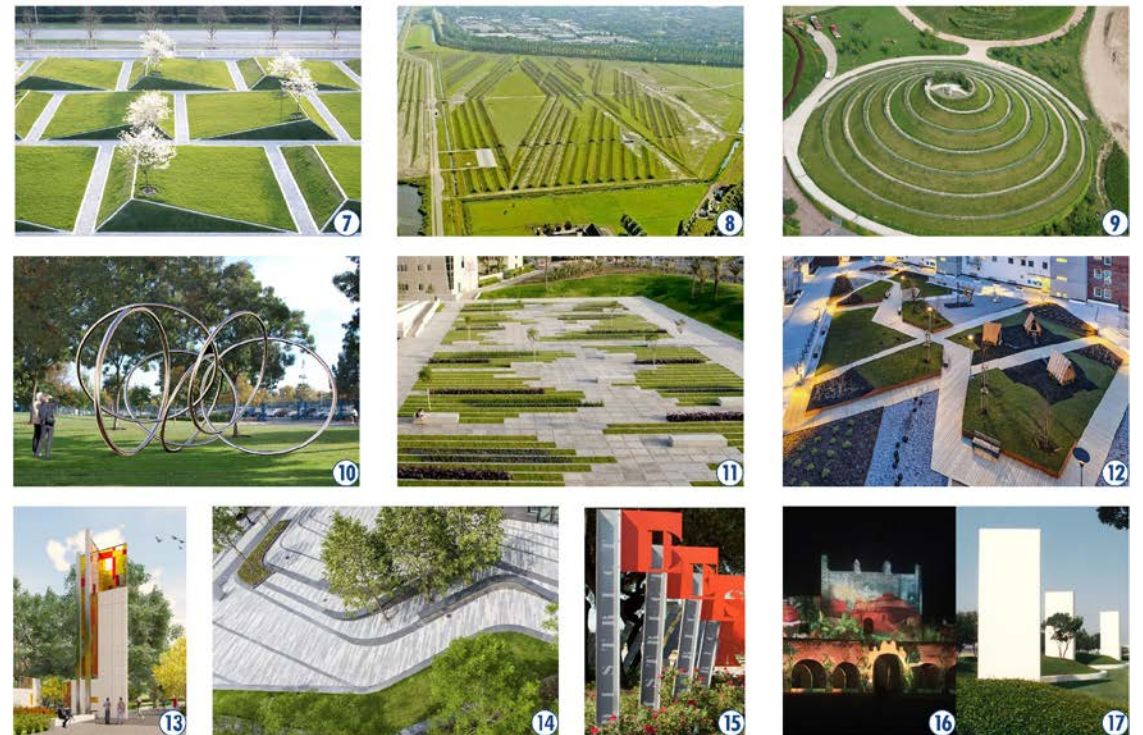
# Virtual Public Outreach Meeting

- A special called Virtual Public Outreach Meeting was held May 5, 2020
- The focus of the meeting was to share preliminary themes and concepts for two parks:

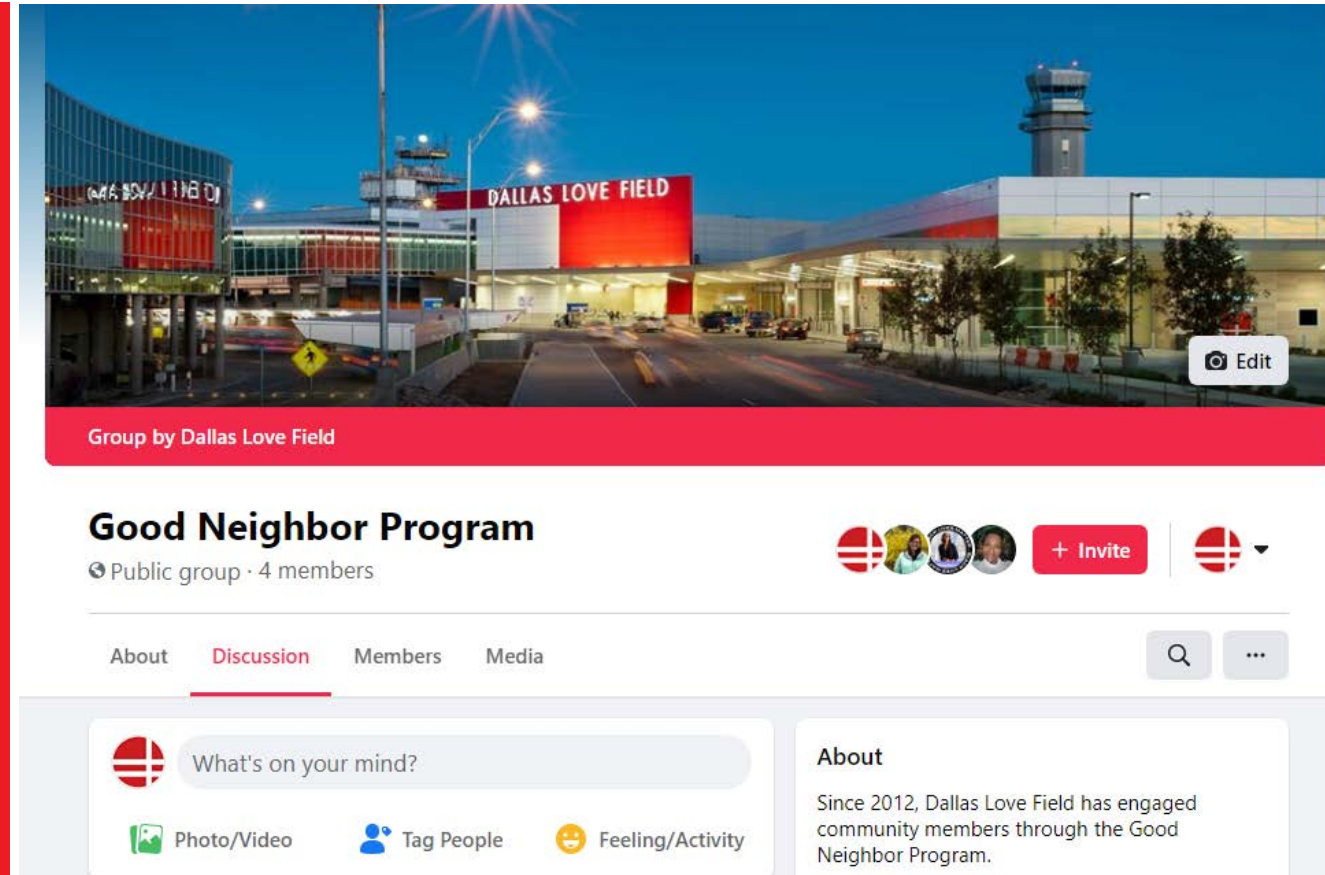

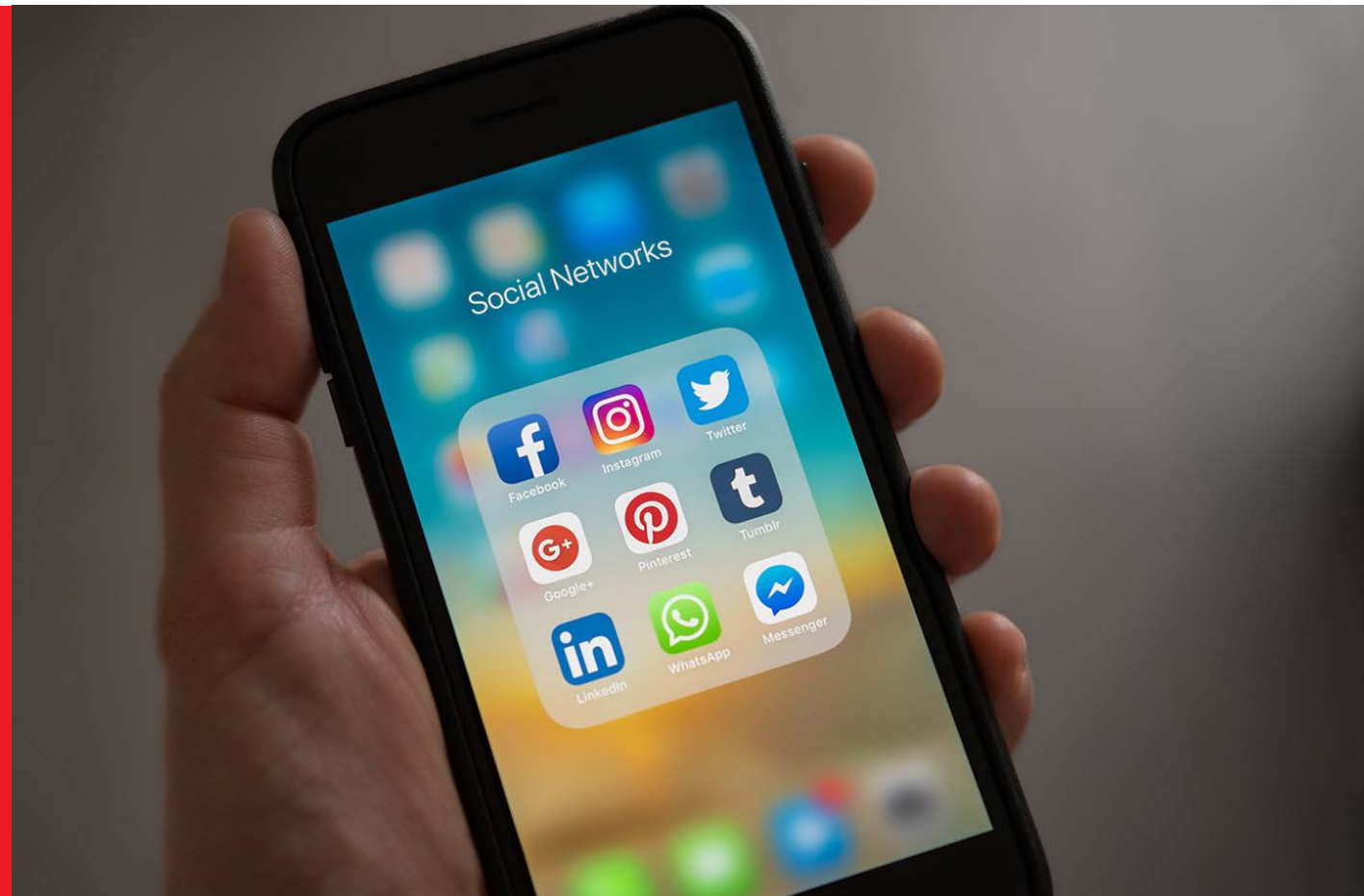

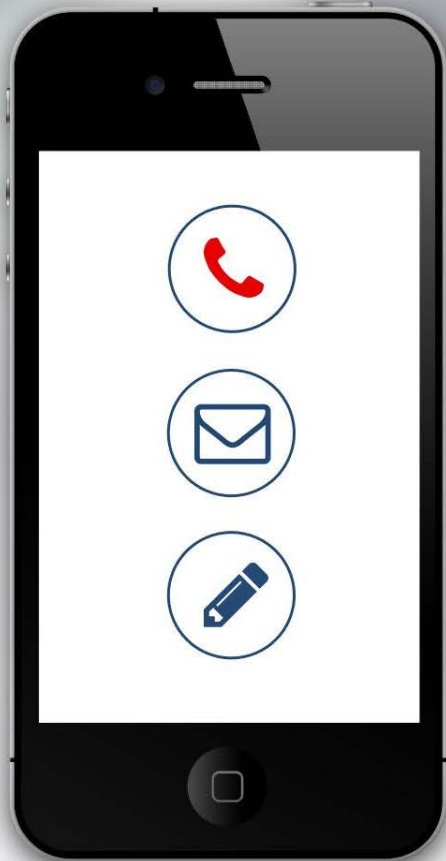
