We are an airport that happens to be in the middle of a community, but.....




Target Areas



Good Neighbor Program –

Love Field Project Updates

Entry Road Enhancements



Construction started in late April 2021 with expected completion in Summer 2022.

Enhancements to include:

- Lighting
- Pedestrian paving
- Fencing
- Landscaping
- Signage
- Public Art

Entry Road Enhancements



Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements

Major design features of the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancement Project may include:

- Enhanced landscaping, urban design elements and gateway features
- Pedestrian and bicycle paths
- Decorative street lights
- Intersection improvements with new traffic signals and crosswalks
- Two neighborhood parks
- Enhanced bus shelters



Updates



- 60% design complete for Trail and Streetscape enhancements, design efforts to 95% level continues
- Estimated design completion – Spring 2022
- 10 ft. shared-use trail with enhanced pedestrian crossings connecting to the Bachman Lake trail system
- Project limits extended to Airdrome and Mockingbird (to Coleville)
- Completed Parks Master Plan
 - Midway Manor Park
 - North Neighborhood Park
- Coordination with other City departments, DART and the FAA
- 2 Secondary Gateway Features at Lovers Lane and Shorecrest Drive

Runway 13R-31L Reconstruction



- Runway 13R/31L is closed until the Spring of 2022 to accommodate its reconstruction
- Project includes replacement of existing pavement system, improvements to the existing drainage & storm water control system, replacement of airfield lighting, improvements to communications pathways and ARFF roadway system
- Closed for approximately ten months beginning **April 2021**
- Aircraft operations have shifted to 13L-31R (Lemmon Avenue runway) while RWY 13R/31L is closed
- Work is progressing with some delays due to previous unusual rain events





- 1. Q: Update on Lemmon Avenue Park and North Entrance
- A. Lemmon Avenue Park : Park design continues as part of the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Improvement project. The project scope has been expanded to include portions of Airdrome and Mockingbird. Design is anticipated to be complete in Spring of 2022.

North Entry: The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) has undertaken an areawide study to analyze various transportation and infrastructure projects in the Bachman Lake area. The study is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2021 and will have recommendations regarding an alternate entry for Love Field. The Department of Aviation will analyze their recommendations before moving forward with Alternate Entry project.

Questions

- 2. Q: Voluntary Noise Abatement and North Entrance
- A. The Voluntary Noise Abatement program is managed by the Love Field Environmental Team (LFEAC) which was established to provide a forum for discussion among airport neighbors, airport operators, and Federal and City aviation representatives on issues related to aircraft noise and noise abatement at Love Field. Members of the committee meet quarterly to review airport operations, propose changes in operations, effectiveness of the noise abatement program, and potential adjustments and improvements to the noise control program.
