What is the Good Neighbor Program?



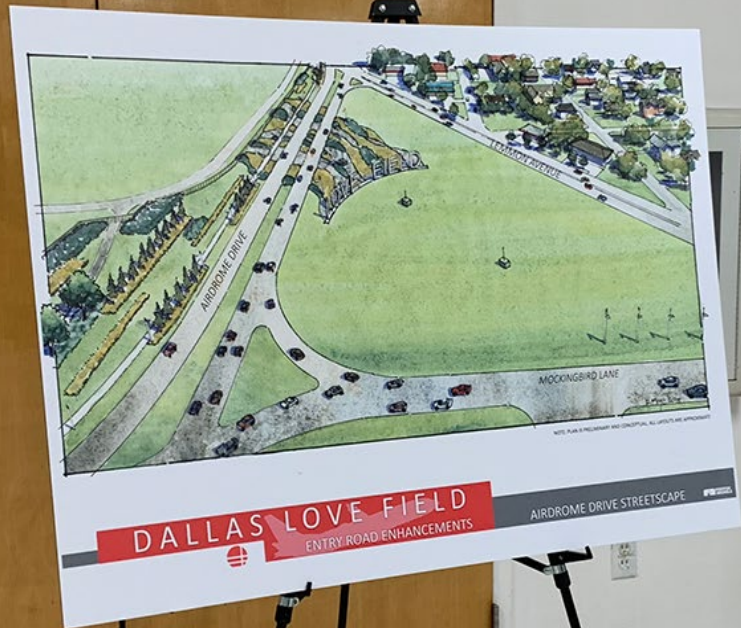
A way to connect with the community on future ideas and planning input.

We are an airport that happens to be in the middle of a community, but.....

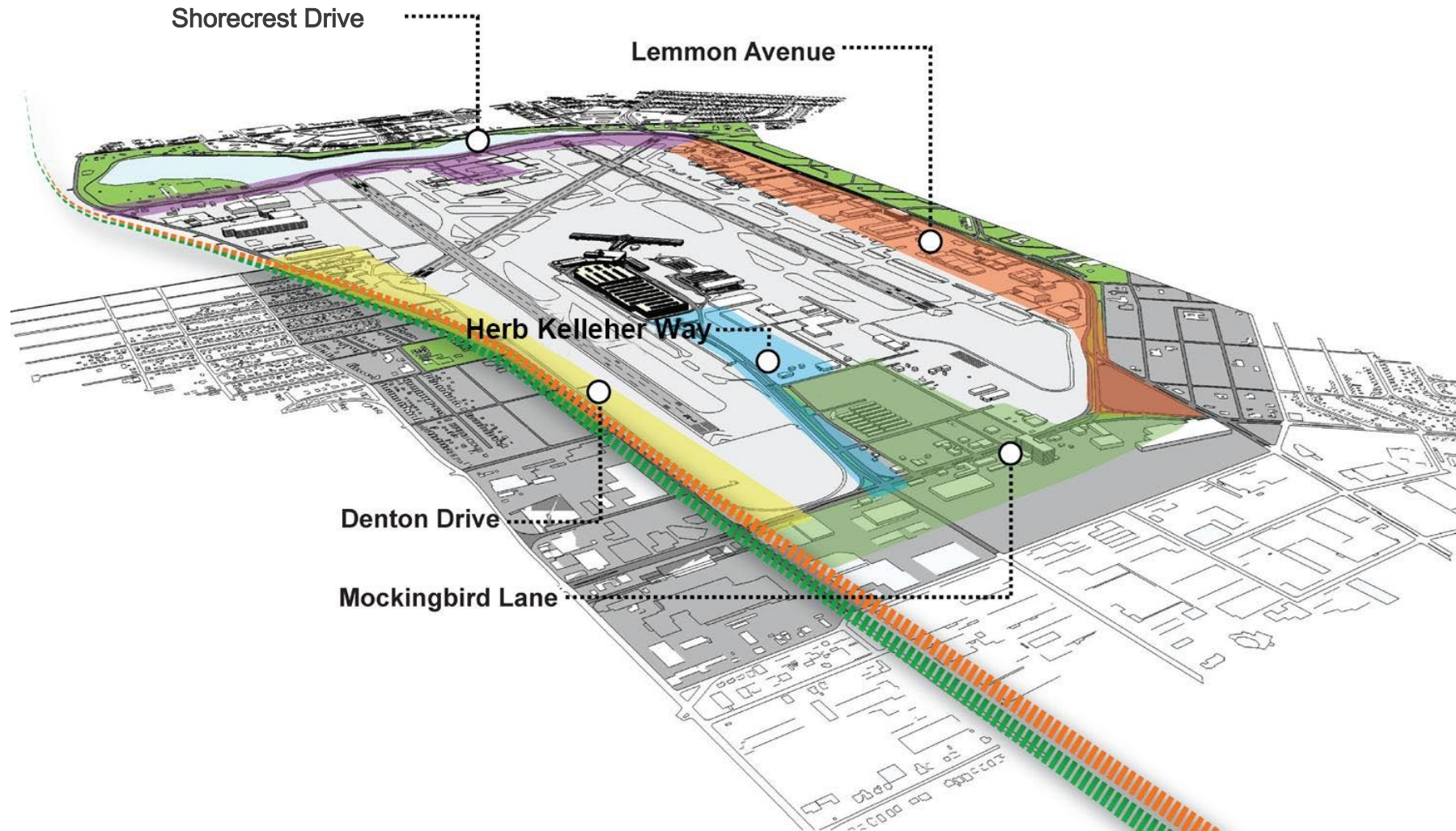

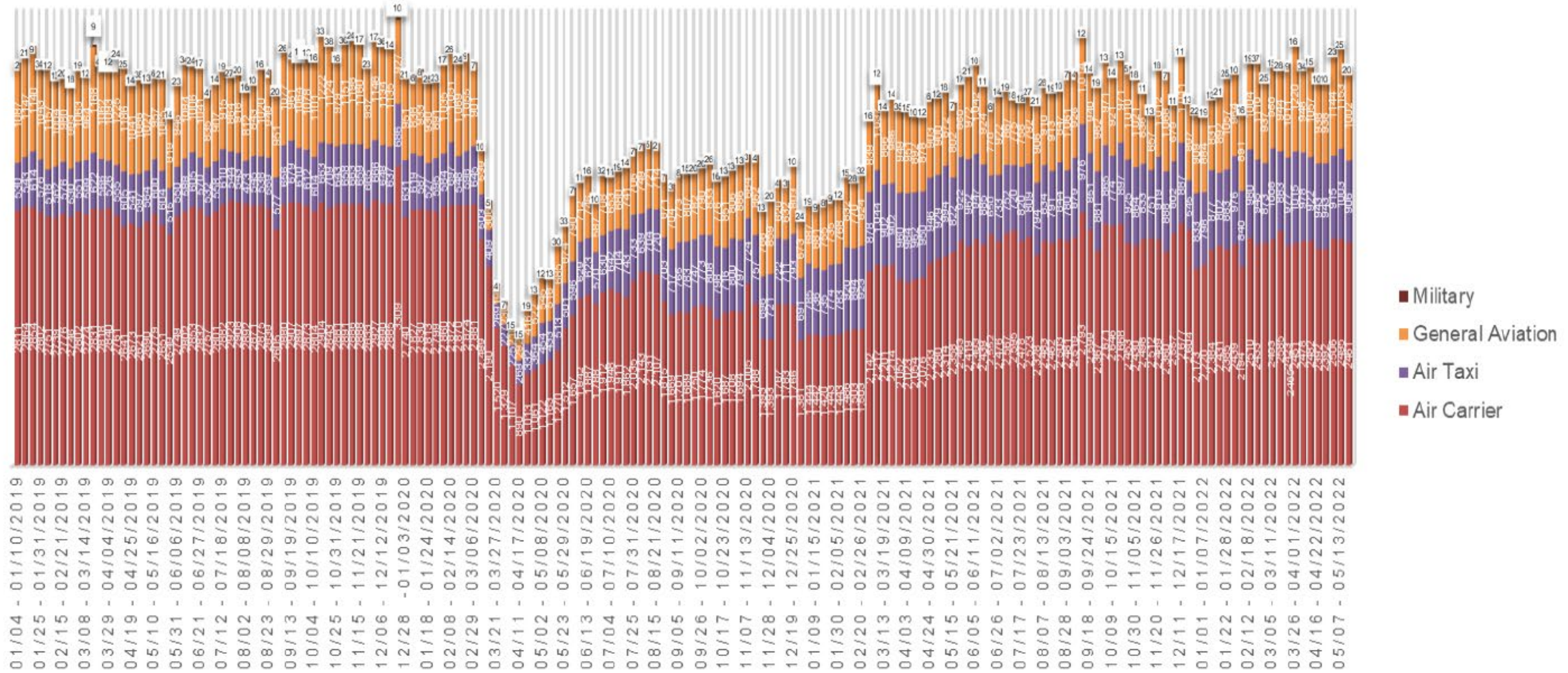

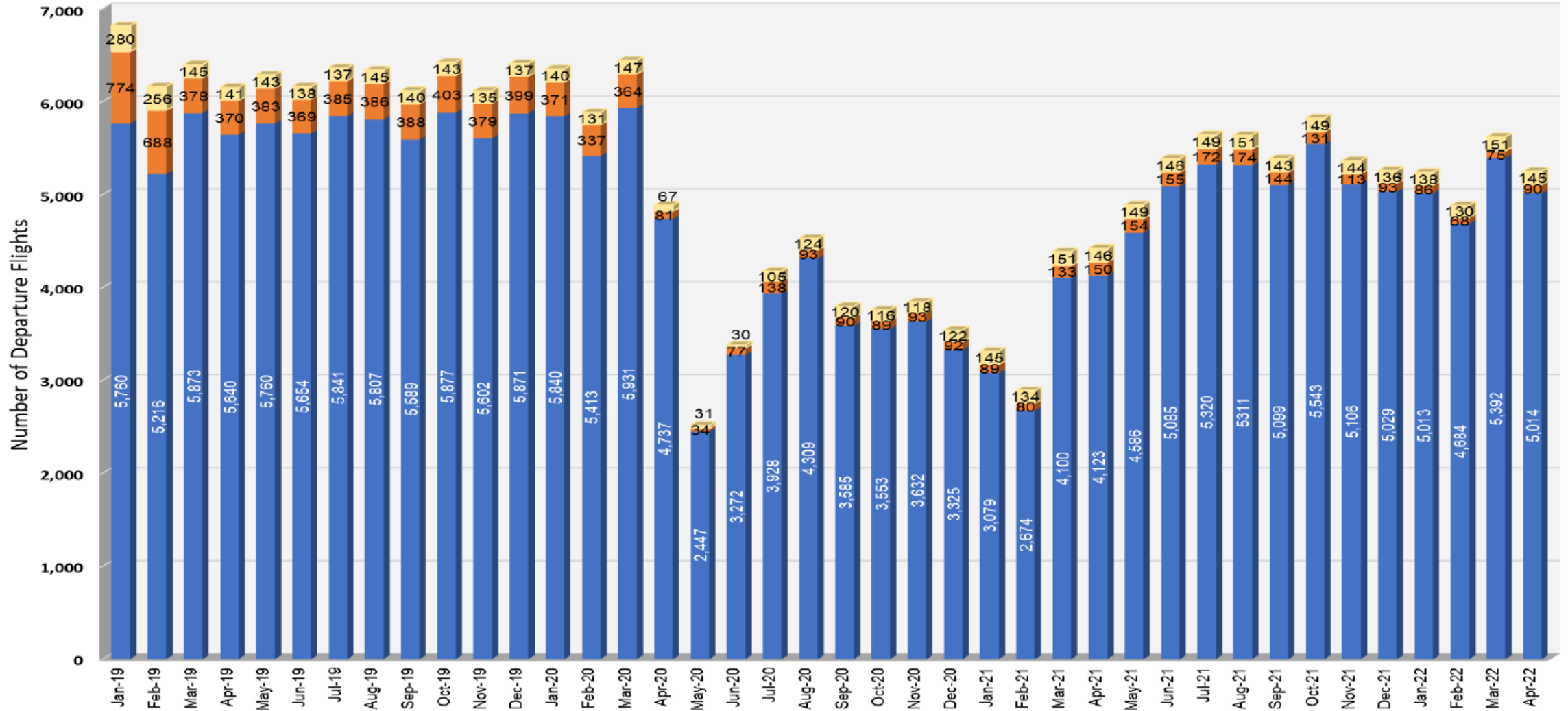

DEPARTURES BY CARRIER

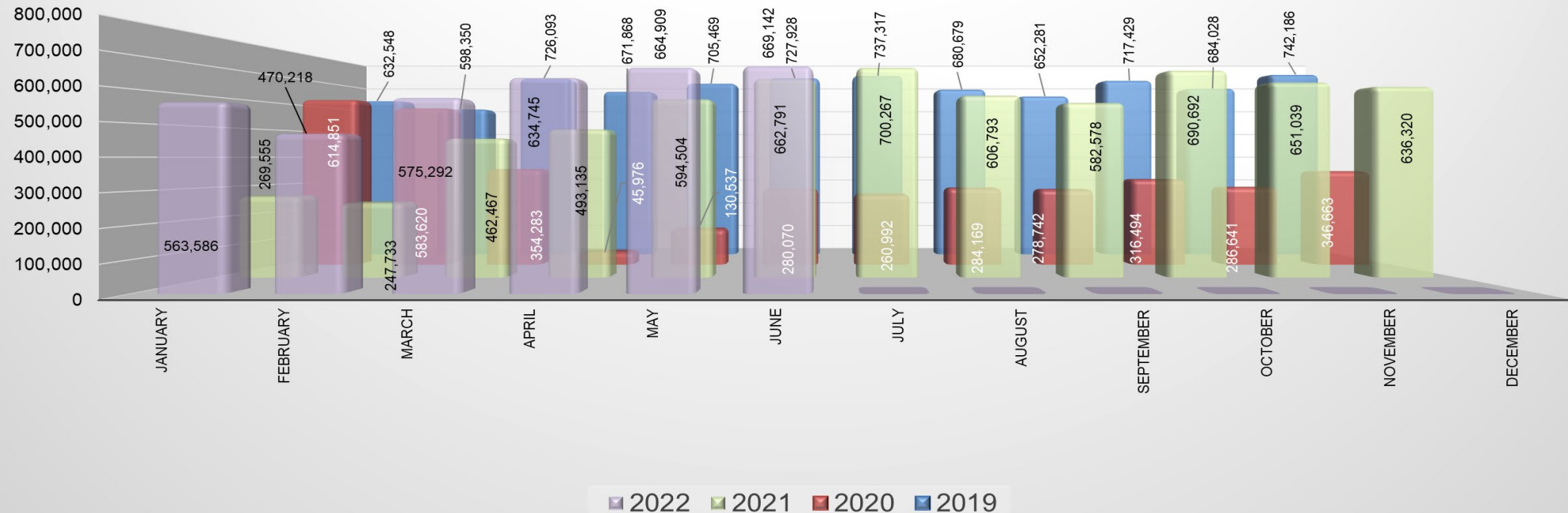
2019 - 2022 Number of Departure Flights by Carrier

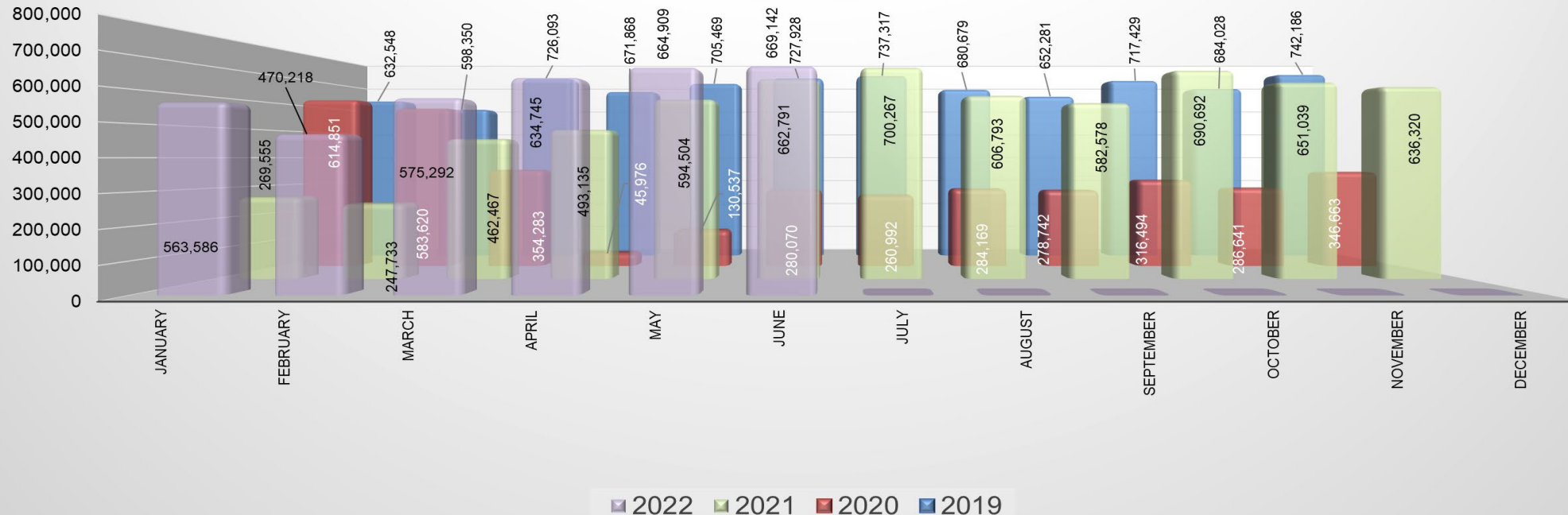

Bachman Lake Marshals/Park Ranger

- Dallas Love Field and Park & Recreation signed Memorandum of Understanding (June 2022)
- Funds full-time Park Ranger and Marshal presence at Bachman Lake Park to patrol the illegal lake activities
 - Address bird feeding which can endanger inbound and outbound aircraft
 - Illegal vending
 - Alcohol consumption
 - Homelessness
- Quality of Life benefit for Dallas residents' safety and security

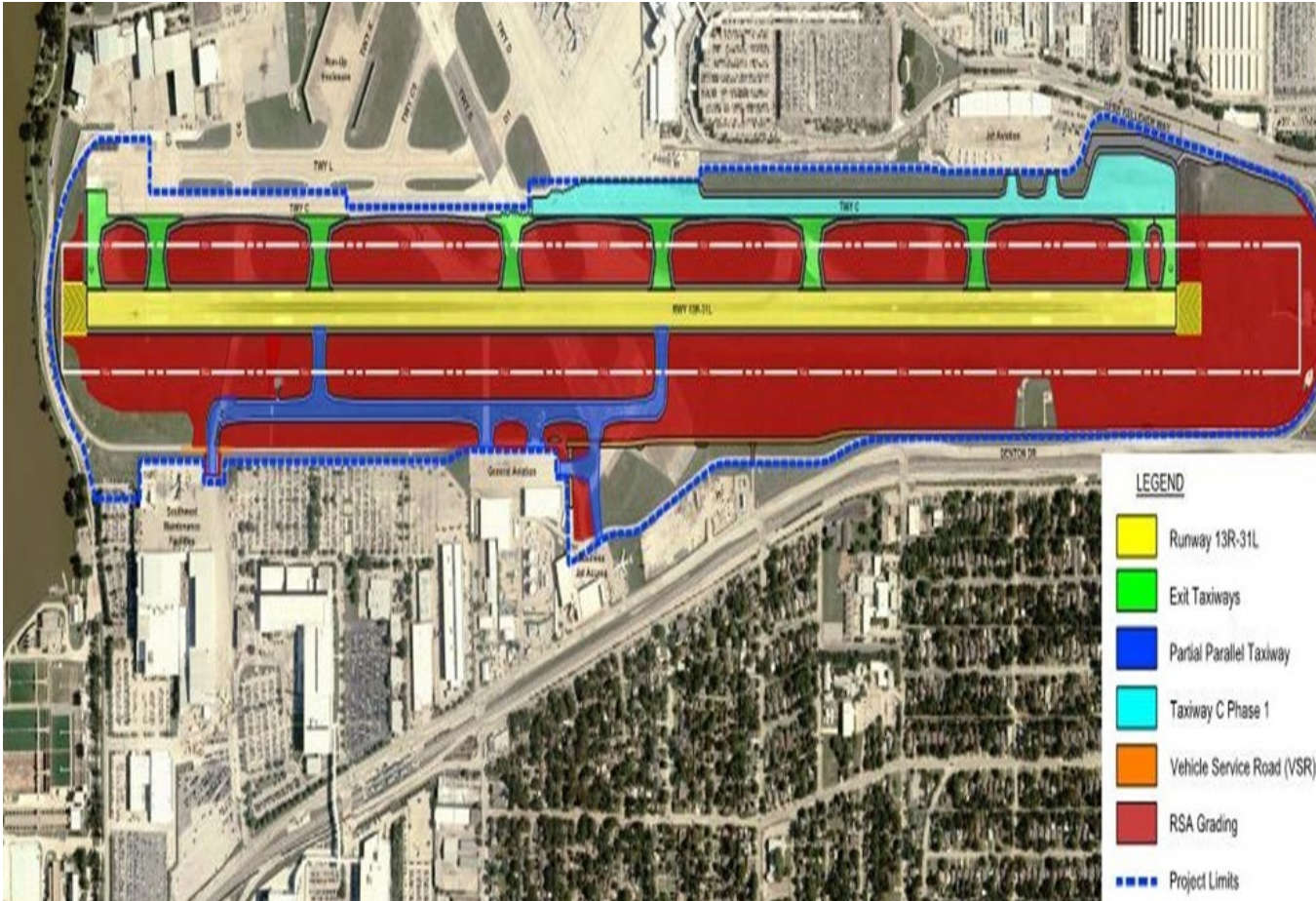
Infrastructure & Development Project Updates

Reconstruct Runway 13R-31L is now OPEN!

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project included replacement of the existing runway and taxiway pavement, improvements to the existing drainage & storm water control system, replacement of airfield lighting, improvements to communications pathways and ARFF roadway system.

- Aircraft operations shifted to 13L-31R (Lemmon Avenue Runway) while RWY 13R/31L was closed.
- Work progressed with some delays due to ongoing supply chain issues, labor shortages and weather delays early in the project.
- Taxiway Tango 5 & Taxiway Charlie 7 reopened March 2, 2022.



Project Status: Construction
Estimated Project Completion: Late 2022
Runway Opened: June 28th

Entry Road Enhancements



Construction started in April 2021 with expected completion in August 2022.

Enhancements to include:

- Lighting
- Pedestrian paving
- Fencing
- Landscaping
- Signage
- Public Art

Cross-Field Taxiways

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

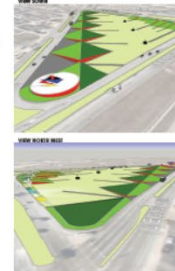
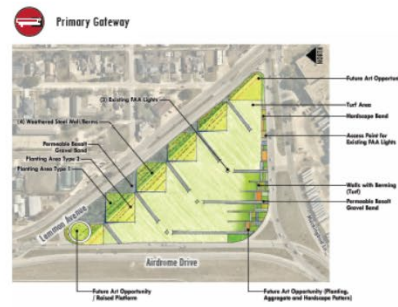
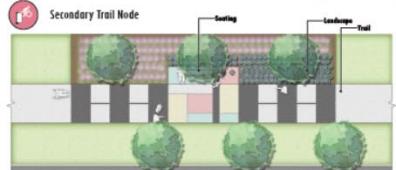
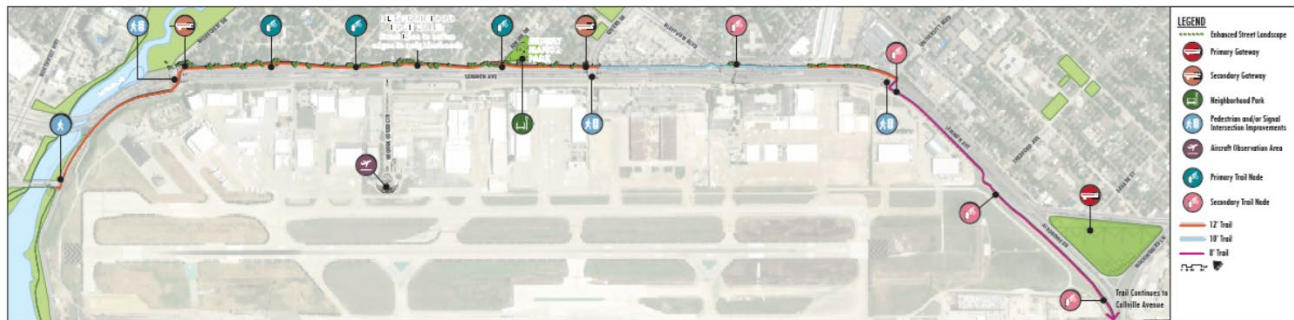
This project will include the construction of Crossfield Taxiways and connecting taxiways, it will also include the construction of the proposed Remain Over Night (RONs), deicing areas, analyze the location of the run-up area and recommend relocation/ reconfiguration.

- Access to the airfield will be from a temporary gate in the existing AOA fence
- Construction access to the site is via the VSR
- This access route will keep construction traffic confined to the site

Project Status: Design Completed
Estimated Construction Start: August 2022



Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements



- 95% design complete for Trail and Streetscape enhancements, design efforts to 90% level continues
- Estimated design completion – Summer 2022
- 12 ft. with 10' in areas with right-of-way constraints shared-use trail with enhanced pedestrian crossings connecting to the Bachman Lake trail system
- Project limits extended to Airdrome and Mockingbird (to Coleville)
- Completed Parks Master Plan
- Midway Manor Park
- Coordination with other City departments, DART and the FAA
- Two (2) Secondary Gateway Features at Lovers Lane and Shorecrest Drive

DAL ARFF Station 21 Replacement

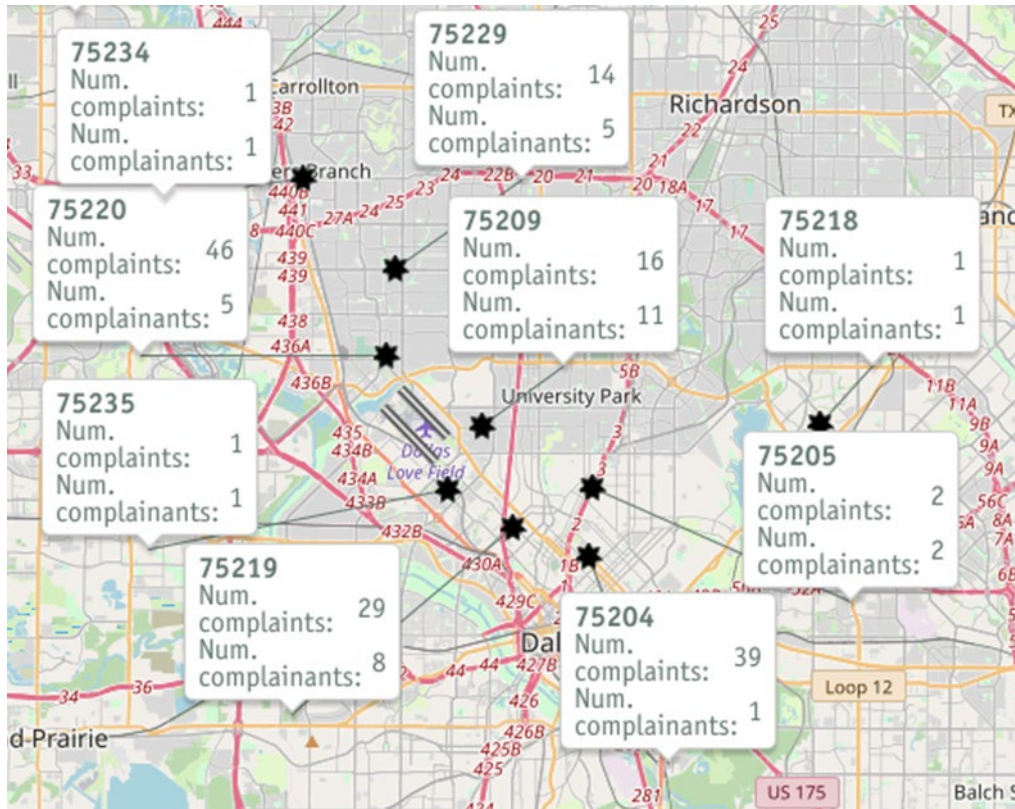


PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Provide a new Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) station to replace existing Station 21.
- Project will include new access roadway and required utilities to provide service to the facility.
- Tentatively scheduled to begin design in Fall 2022

Updating Voluntary Noise Program

- April 13, 2022 – DOA briefed the City of Dallas' Environmental Commission
- May 2, 2022 – DOA briefed the Environment & Sustainability Council Committee
- As an outcome, DOA will host stakeholder meetings to review the Voluntary Noise Program (VNP) by discussing DAL's current program and provide feasible noise measures to the FAA for their review and implementation
 - Venue for the City of Dallas to engage with the communities of Dallas Love Field Airport
 - Aims to provide information, the opportunity to review the existing program, and suggest new/modified noise mitigating measures
 - In addition to residents, airport tenants, schools/churches, and subject matter experts will also be present for their perspective and to discuss any potential impacts

Objectives and Timeline

Review the current Noise Program and make recommendations to update:

- Sunsetting outdated measures
- Updating existing/outdated measures
- Proposing new feasible measures to be reviewed by Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)

Airport Carbon Accreditation

- Institutionally – endorsed, global carbon management certification program for airports
- Current status: Level 3 – Optimization (June 2022)
 - Level 2 – Reduction (2018)
 - Level 1 – Mapping (2017)
- Reached carbon reduction objective to “reduce emissions by 10 percent per enplaned passenger below 2015 levels by 2025”
- Looking forward:
 - Achieve Level 3+ – Carbon Neutrality



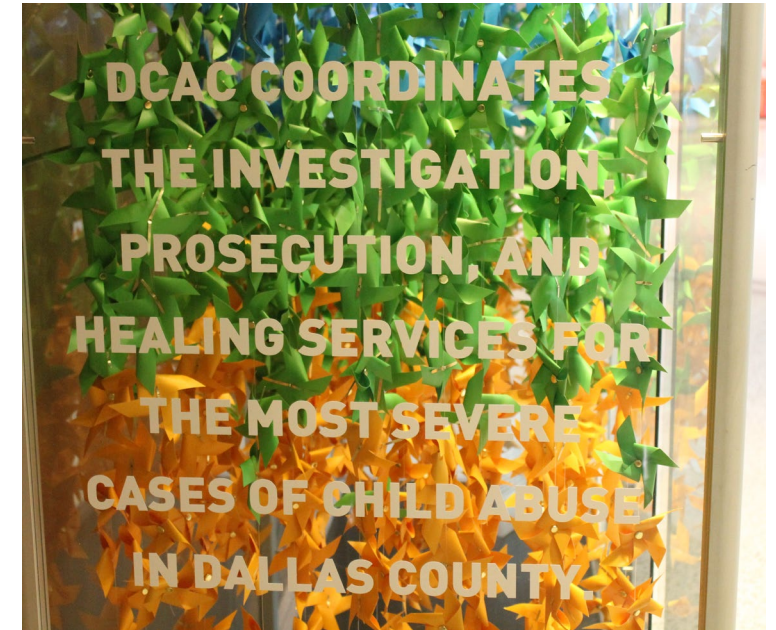
