"Our goal is to be a community that happens to be located around an airport..."






LOVE FIELD OPERATIONS

DAL OPERATIONS DATA






DEPARTURES BY CARRIER

Entry Road Enhancements










Construction started in April 2021 with expected completion in October 2022.

Enhancements include:

- Lighting
- Pedestrian paving
- Fencing
- Landscaping
- Signage
- Public Art




Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements



- 99% design complete for Trail and Streetscape enhancements, FAA coordination continues
- Estimated construction start Spring 2023
- 12 ft. mixed-use with 10' in areas with right-ofway constraints with enhanced pedestrian crossings connecting to the Bachman Lake trail system
- Project limits extended to Airdrome and Mockingbird (@ Coleville)
- Completed Parks Master Plan
- Midway Manor Park
- Main Gateway feature at Lemmon/Airdrome triangle and two (2) Secondary Gateway Features at Lovers Lane and Shorecrest Drive



Cross-Field Taxiways



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will include the construction of Crossfield Taxiways and connecting taxiways, it will also include the construction of the proposed Remain Over Night (RONs), deicing areas, analyze the location of the run-up area and recommend relocation/ reconfiguration.

- Access to the airfield will be from a temporary gate in the existing AOA fence
- Construction access to the site is via the VSR
- This access route will keep construction traffic confined to the site

DAL ARFF Station 21 Replacement




PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Provide a new Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) station to replace existing Station 21.
- Project will include new access roadway and required utilities to provide service to the facility.
- Council Approved design award on September 14, 2022.



DAL Taxiway A Reconstruction



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Rehabilitate Taxiway Alpha.
- Realign the vehicle Service Road
- Review and assess the Runway Safety Area for runway 13L-31R.
- Council Approved design award on September 14, 2022.

Noise Stakeholders Meeting

- The Department of Aviation is currently hosting a series of noise stakeholder meetings to review
 the Voluntary Noise Program (VNP) by discussing DAL's current program and provide feasible
 noise measures to the FAA for their review and implementation.
- Goal to provide information on aircraft noise, the opportunity to review the existing program, and suggest new/modified feasible noise mitigating measures.
- Stakeholders consist of a third-party Facilitator, Consultants (HMMH), Federal Government (FAA),
 Department of Aviation Staff, Airline representatives, Airport tenants, School representatives,
 Neighborhood Associations, and Individual Residents.







Flight Tracker


Dallas Love Field Airport has invested in an online tracking system for the movement of flights within the DFW Metroplex. Flight Tracker allows concerned individuals to research data on flights. The system simplifies the submission of noise complaints by offering an easy, online option for residents to register noise concerns.

Submitting a Noise Complaint



Guidelines and Standards

- •Noise complaints will only be logged when they contain accurate and complete information, including the **first and last** name, physical address, date and time of the noise occurrence and means of contact (telephone number or email address) if feedback is requested.
- •It is recommended that noise complaints should be reported within one week of the occurrence.
- •The FAA's Aviation Noise Ombudsman serves as a public liaison for issues about aircraft noise questions and complaints.

DAL Achieves Level 3 Airport Carbon Accreditation


