Operates in and around the airport with the mission to do all the good we can, in all the ways we can.



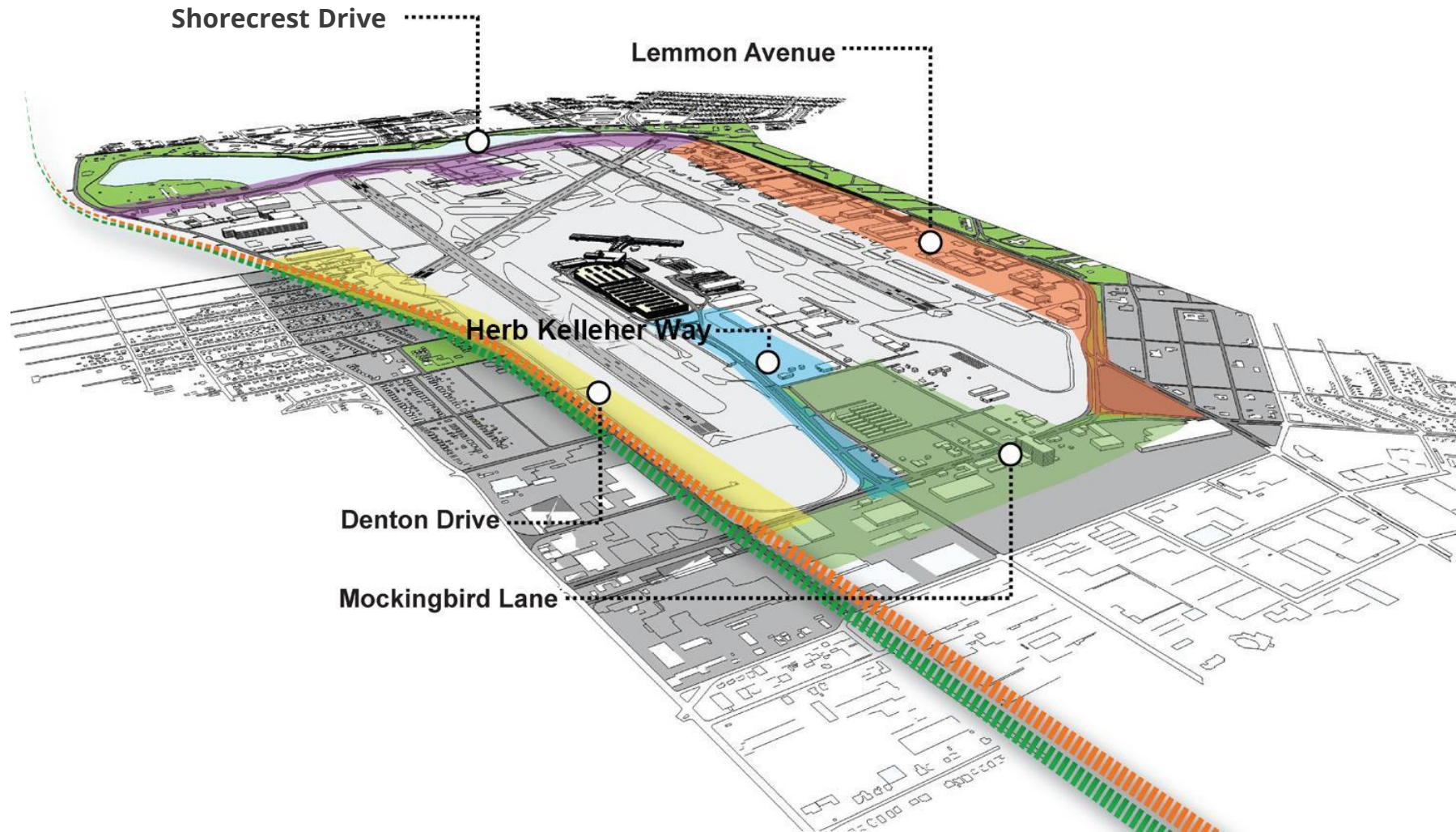
Good Neighbor Program Goals

Good Neighbor Program –

Infrastructure & Development Project Updates

Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements



- 100% design complete for Trail and Streetscape enhancements; FAA coordination continues
- Estimated construction start – Fall 2023
- 12 ft. mixed-use with 10' in areas with right-of-way constraints with enhanced pedestrian crossings connecting to the Bachman Lake Trail system
- Main Gateway feature at Lemmon Avenue/Airdrome Drive triangle and two (2) secondary gateway features at Lovers Lane and Shorecrest Drive
- Project limits extended to Airdrome Drive and Mockingbird Lane (@ Collville Avenue)

Cross-Field Taxiways



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will include the construction of Crossfield Taxiways and connecting taxiways, it will also include the construction of the proposed Remain Over Night (RONs), deicing areas, analyze the location of the run-up area and recommend relocation/reconfiguration.

- Access to the airfield will be from a temporary gate in the existing AOA fence
- Construction access to the site is via the VSR
- This access route will keep construction traffic confined to the site

Project status: Construction
Estimated Project Completion: Winter 2024

DAL ARFF Station 21 Replacement

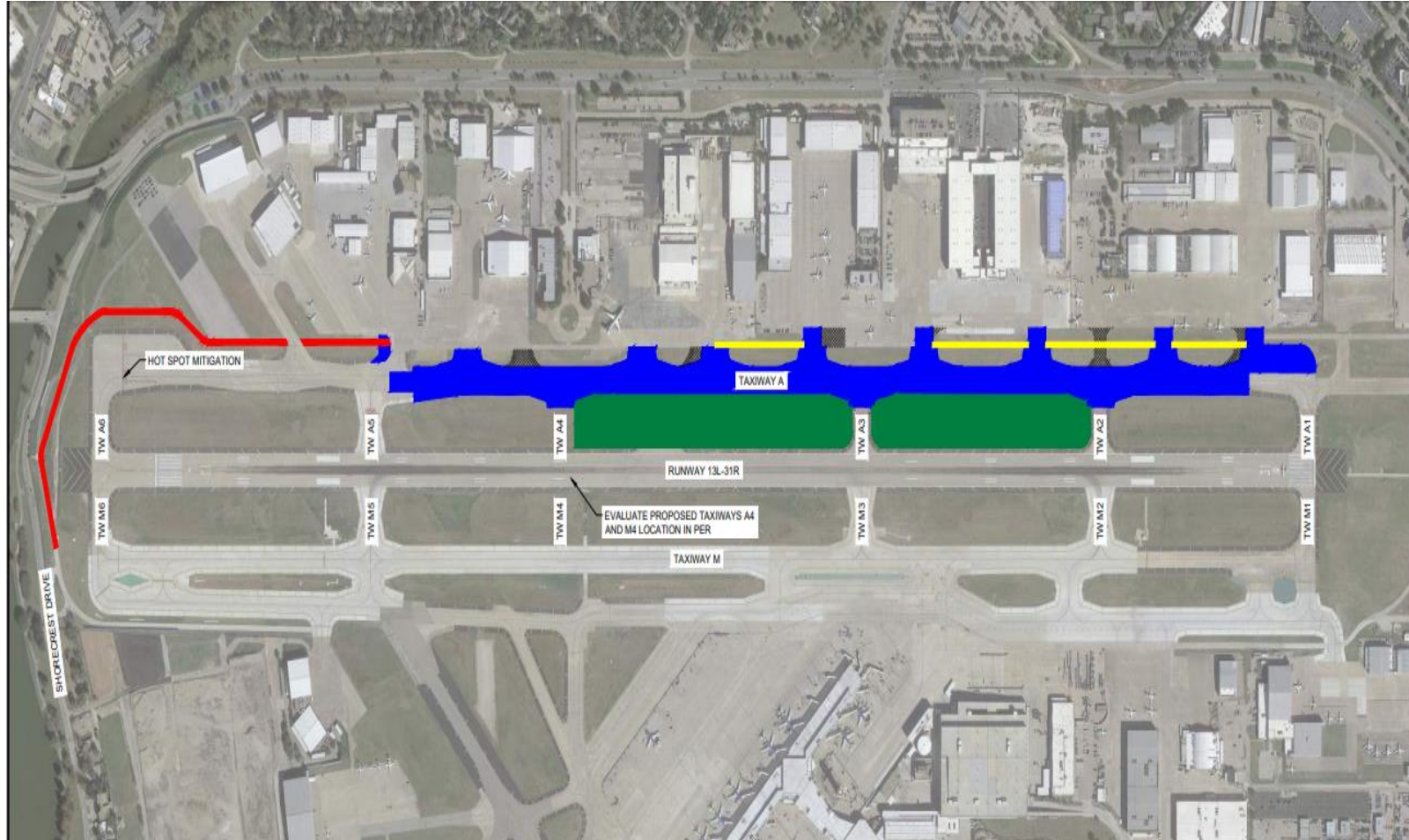


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Project will include new access roadway and required utilities to provide service to the facility.

Guidelines and Standards

- Noise complaints will only be logged when they contain accurate and complete information, including the **first and last name, physical address, date and time of the noise occurrence** and **means of contact** (telephone number or email address) if feedback is requested.
- It is recommended that noise complaints should be reported within one week of the occurrence.
- The FAA's Aviation Noise Ombudsman serves as a public liaison for issues about aircraft noise questions and complaints.

- Q. New to the neighborhood and wanting to learn more about pedestrian/bike access improvements along Lemmon Avenue/Shorecrest to Bachman Lake.
- A. The Lemmon Ave, Streetscape Enhancements project will construct quality of life improvements in the vicinity of Dallas Love Field Airport starting at Collville Avenue and extending down Lemmon Avenue to Shorecrest Drive, and Webb Chapel Extension. Construction of streetscape enhancements includes sidewalks, bicycle paths, landscaping, gateway features, lighting, intersection safety improvements, traffic signals, wayfinding signage and an upgrade to Midway Manor Park. The improvements are intended to provide a more walkable neighborhood and improve pedestrian circulation and safety through enhanced pathways and bike connectivity to other City trails and recreation within the vicinity of the airport.

Questions

- Q. What does your community engagement look like? What are the efforts you commit to give back to the community?
- A. Dallas Airport System works in collaboration with our airport tenants, concessionaires and City departments, along with our surrounding communities to address issues affecting the well-being of our neighborhoods and business owners. The Community Engagement strategies include strengthening relationships with organizations within 2.5 miles of each airport, attending scheduled meetings to share airport updates, and supporting partner events.
