

Sum of Alaska Airlines started trending up on April 2022, rising by 21.18% (4,090) in 16 months. Sum of Delta Airlines jumped from 26,028 to 47,443 during its steepest incline between March 2023 and August 2023. Sum of Southwest Airlines experienced the longest period of growth (+422,589) between April 2021 and August 2023. Sum of Southwest Airlines fell by 120,721 in the last Month.





Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements

Dallas Airport System

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Construction Notice to Proceed provided on September 15, 2023
- Construction to begin in October; estimated 21 months
- 12 ft. mixed-use with 10' in areas with right-ofway constraints with enhanced pedestrian crossings connecting to the Bachman Lake Trail system
- Main Gateway feature at Lemmon Avenue/Airdrome Drive triangle and two (2) secondary gateway features at Lovers Lane and Shorecrest Drive
- Project limits extended to Airdrome Drive and Mockingbird Lane (@ Collville Avenue)





Crossfield Taxiways

Dallas Airport System

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will include the construction of Crossfield Taxiways and connecting taxiways, it will also include the construction of the proposed Remain Over Night (RONs), deicing areas, analyze the location of the run-up area and recommend relocation/reconfiguration.


- Access to the airfield will be from a temporary gate in the existing AOA fence
- Construction access to the site is via the VSR

This access route will keep construction traffic confined to the site.


13L-31R Runway Safety Area Evaluation and Taxiway A Rehab

- Q. I am excited about the Lemon avenue beautification with added sidewalks, landscaping and parks. I just went to the recent Calloway's nursery on Lemon and was surprised to see the sidewalk built right next to Lemmon with not even a foot of grass buffer. I'm addition, there is no room to move the sidewalk away from the street as the sea of parking lots are everywhere. No trees or landscaping along the street (and this a plant nursery?) as well unlike the landscaped city aviation office next door. I'm just surprised by the proposal compared to what I just saw at Calloway's as recent development. At least Calloway's didn't put up a lighted 20-foot pole sign or billboard.
- A. The improvements being made with the Lemmon Ave. Streetscape Enhancements project will only be made on City of Dallas property that allows enough room for the trail and landscaping buffer. The sidewalk in front of Calloway's Nursery was not included in this scope of work.
